"Violation of biological command has been the failure of social man. Vertebrates though we may be, we have ignored the law of equal opportunity since civilization's earliest hours. Sexually reproducing beings though we are, we pretend today that the law of inequality does not exist. And enlightened though we may be, while we pursue the unattainable we make impossible the realizable." In his two previous books, Robert Ardrey exploded a series of philosophical landmines. African Genesis (1961) introduced his new evolutionary approach to an understanding of men. Then came The Territorial Imperative (1966), whose title is now a common phrase in our language. The Social Contract is the third in the series, and it denies that men are created equal - but that they deserve absolute equality of opportunity. Robert Ardrey maintains that since the publication of Rousseau's Social Contract two centuries ago, men have wasted social resources, converted much of education into a process of brain-washing, committed themselves to one political insane asylum after another, all in pursuit of a goal that is a natural impossibility in any sexually reproducing species. Discarding the myth, Robert Ardrey

combines his wealth of knowledge of animal ways with the new insights of modern biology and the newest revelations concerning human evolution to probe perplexing contemporary problems: the revolt of the young, the status struggle and the role of leadership, population control, urban overcrowding, violence in civilized life. This brilliant classic offers a powerful challenge to accustomed thought. Car chacun d'entre eux pourra être couplé à une molécule active bien ciblée, et leur efficacité sera même améliorée pour peu qu'on parvienne à conjuguer leur action. Qu'un

récepteur, qu'une molécule, propres au métabolisme ou à la physiologie d'une cellule cancéreuse soient identifiés, et des toxines conjuguées à un ligand de ce récepteur, de cette molécule (ce peut être un anticorps) bloqueront les canaux ioniques ou exerceront leur effet cytolytique sur cette seule cellule, sans nuire aux cellules saines. Nous voilà dégagés de l'utopie, le contenu de cet ouvrage le prouve abondamment. Et même si la concrétisation des promesses reste délicate, le champ d'action est si vaste initialement qu'il ne saurait rester improductif : il ne l'est d'ailleurs déjà plus.

The Social Contract

The International Conference on Fracture Mechanics Technology Applied to Material Evaluation and Structure Design was held in Melbourne, Australia, from August 10 to 13, 1982. It was sponsored jointly by the Australian Fracture Group and Institute of Fracture and Solid Mechanics at Lehigh University. Professor G. C. Sih of Lehigh University, Drs. N. E. Ryan and R. Jones of Aeronautical Research Laboratories served as Co-Chairmen. They initiated the organization of this international event to provide an opportunity for the practitioners, engineers and interested individuals to present and discuss recent advances in the evaluation of material and structure damage originating from defects or cracks. Particular emphases were placed on applying the fracture mechanics technology for assessing interactions between material properties, design and operational requirements. It is timely to hold such a Conference in Australia as she embarks on technology extensive industries where safeguarding structures from premature and unexpected failure is essential from both the technical and economical points. The application of system-type approach to failure control owes much of its success to fracture mechanics. It is now generally accepted that the discipline, when properly implemented, provides a sound engineering basis for accounting in interactions between material properties, design, fabrication, inspection and operational requirements. The approach offers effective solutions for design and maintenance of large-scale energy generation plants, mining machineries, oil exploration and retrieval equipments, land, sea and air transport vehicles.

Directory of British Scientific Instrument Makers, 1550-1851

Chicago's extensive transit system first started in 1859, when horsecars ran on rails in city streets. Cable cars and electric streetcars came next. Where new trolley car lines were built, people, businesses, and neighborhoods followed. Chicago quickly became a world-class city. At its peak, Chicago had over 3,000 streetcars and 1,000 miles of track--the largest such system in the world. By the 1930s, there were also streamlined trolleys and trolley buses on rubber tires. Some parts of

Chicago's famous "L" system also used trolley wire instead of a third rail. Trolley cars once took people from the Loop to such faraway places as Aurora, Elgin, Milwaukee, and South Bend. A few still run today.
