The introductory chapters deal with the various strategies for disease vector control and provide an overview of herbal biomedicines. The subsequent chapter describes plants with

mosquito larvicidal activity, including a comprehensive list of lethal concentrations against different mosquito species. The chapter on Himalayan plants discusses potential botanical insecticide sources and their chemical constituents before delving into the topic of natural insecticides of microbial origin and their efficacy against mosquitoes. Plant-derived insecticides belonging to different chemical classes and the extraction, purification and characterisation of bioactive compounds are illustrated, as well. The recent technological advances in the formulation of microbial, biochemical and botanical insecticides are also reviewed. Three chapters focus on important medicinal plants useful for treating human ailments, with special reference to the traditional healing practices of northeastern India. This is followed by a chapter on the production, use and safety of biopharmaceuticals and edible, plant-based vaccines. The intellectual property issues related to herbal products in India including patents, trademarks, geographical indications, trade secrets and traditional knowledge resources are plainly examined. The book ends with a chapter on the herbal product registration process in India, wherein the data requirements for registration, clinical efficacy trials, toxicity studies, quality control, packaging and labelling are clearly explained. In conclusion, this book is a step-by-step guide for the development of safe, effective and commercially viable herbal insecticides, repellents and biomedicines.

The Transsexual Phenomenon

Gay. Straight. Or lying. It's as simple and straightforward as black or white, right? Or is there a gray area, where the definitions of sex and gender become blurred or entirely refocused with the deft and practiced use of a surgeon's knife? For some, the concept of gender—the very idea we have of ourselves as either male or female beings—is neither simple nor straightforward. Written by cutting-edge researcher and sex expert J. Michael Bailey, *The Man Who Would Be Queen* is a frankly controversial, intensely poignant, and boldly forthright book about sex and gender. Based on his original research, Bailey's book is grounded firmly in science. But as he demonstrates, science doesn't always deliver predictable or even comfortable answers. Indeed, much of what he has to say will be sure to generate as many questions as it does answers. Are gay men genuinely more feminine than other men? And do they really prefer to be hairdressers rather than lumberjacks? Are all male transsexuals women trapped in men's bodies—or are some of them men who are just plain turned on by the idea of becoming a woman? And how much of a role do biology and genetics play in sexual orientation? But while Bailey's science is provocative, it is the portraits of the boys and men who struggle with these questions—and often with anger, fear, and hurt feelings—that will move you. You will meet Danny, an eight-year-old boy whose favorite game is playing house and who yearns to dress up as a princess for Halloween. And Martin, an expert makeup artist who was plagued by inner turmoil as a youth but is now openly homosexual and has had many men as sex partners. And Kim, a strikingly sexy transsexual who still has a penis and works

as a dancer and a call girl for men who like she-males while she awaits sex reassignment surgery. These and other stories make it clear that there are men " and men who become women " who want only to understand themselves and the society that makes them feel like outsiders. That there are parents, friends, and families that seek answers to confusing and complicated questions. And that there are researchers who hope one day to grasp the very nature of human sexuality. As the striking cover image " a distinctly muscular and obviously male pair of legs posed in a pair of low-heeled pumps " makes clear, the concept of gender, the very idea we have of ourselves as either male or female beings, is neither simple nor straightforward for some.

The novel "Ms. Quixote Goes Country - Raised on the Marxist Frontier" is the sequel to the novel "Hairy Spanish Girl". Leave it to the author L.E. Vega to defy with boldness and assurance by sailing straight through as a writer. Having very modern ideas, the author's original goal was to sculpture the literary image of an educated Hispanic woman, something practically unheard of in 1980 when the novel was conceived. The achieved result, however, is a humorous progression of an unyielding hairy Spanish girl who keeps quiet and does not draw attention. Picture Libby Castillo, a youngish Spanish American woman in the heart of New York City who could easily be a real life character in any of today's circles. She is forced to work from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. in order to surreptitiously be out of the office before she grows her hysterical five o'clock shadow. Her peculiar plot leads the reader through a series of hairy situations that can only be described as engaging

in chapters that resound the amusing but harmless world of Salvador Dalí.

Media Laboratories explores a pivotal time for South American literature of the 1930s and '40s. Cinema, radio, and the typewriter, once seen as promising catalysts for new kinds of writing, began to be challenged by authors, workers, and the public.
